How to download and embed series short

Go to www.survival.tv

Click on the The Briefing Room

Select series short

Download documentaries

Click on the Downloads button at the very bottom of the page

Click on the Quicktime or WMV icon (to choose the format of the downloaded video) next to the film title you want to download



Embed documentaries

Click on the embed button

Copy the player file URL to the clipboard

Enter the code onto your Web site
